- 6. The reported price in Column 4 is a weighted average price. These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$140.12 to \$140.43 per share, inclusive. - 9. 25% of the shares subject to this option vested on September 2, 2015, and the remaining shares subject to this option vest in 36 equal monthly installments thereafter, subject to the Reporting Person's continued service to the Issuer through each vesting date. The option is early exercisable by the Reporting Person.
- 10. Each share of Class B common stock is convertible into one share of Class A common stock at the option of the holder and has no expiration date.
- 11. A portion of these shares represent RSUs. Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Issuer's Class B Common Stock.
- 12. This option shall vest as follows: 1/4th of the option shall vest on January 1, 2018 and 1/48th of the option shall vest monthly thereafter, subject to the Reporting Person's continued service to the Issuer through 13. The shares subject to this option vest in 48 equal monthly installments, with the first installment on March 15, 2018, subject to the Reporting Person's continued service to the Issuer through each vesting date.
- 14. The shares subject to this option vest in 48 equal monthly installments, with the first installment on February 15, 2016, subject to the Reporting Person's continuous service to the Issuer through each vesting date. The option is early exercisable by the Reporting Person.
- 15. The stock option shall vest as follows: 33% of the stock option shall vest on December 31, 2020, 33% of the stock option shall vest on December 31, 2021 and 34% of the stock option shall vest on December

31, 2022, subject to the Reporting Person's continued service to the Issuer through each vesting date.
